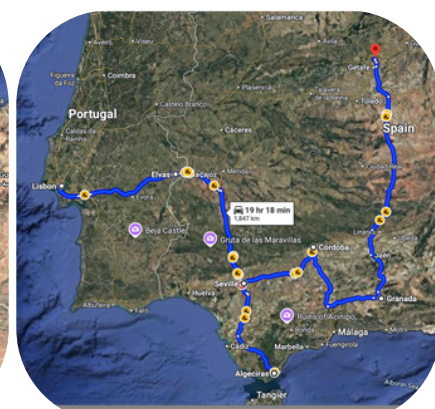

# Itinerary

## DAY 1 CASABLANCA - MARRAKECH (MOB/L)

Arrive at Casablanca Mohammed V International Airport. Your journey begins with a visit to the Hassan II Mosque, the largest mosque in Morocco and the 7th largest in the world. Its stunning minaret rises 210 meters, and the mosque features intricate mosaics, marble floors, and a glass floor revealing the Atlantic Ocean beneath. Next, drive along the Corniche Ain Diab, Casablanca's scenic coastal promenade lined with cafes and beaches. Continue to Marrakesh (approx. 3 hours). In the evening, explore Jemaa El-Fnaa Square, a UNESCO-listed open-air theater where storytellers, musicians, snake charmers, and vendors gather. Experience the vibrant energy and cultural richness of this historic market square. **OVERNIGHT MARRAKECH**

## DAY 2 MARRAKESH CITY TOUR (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the Koutoubia Mosque, Marrakesh's largest mosque, famed for its 77-meter tall minaret and beautiful gardens surrounding it. Discover the Saadian Tombs, dating back to the 16th century, rediscovered in 1917, with elaborately decorated chambers showcasing the craftsmanship of the Saadian dynasty. Wander through the Majorelle Garden, designed by French painter Jacques Majorelle and later owned by fashion icon Yves Saint Laurent, featuring exotic plants, fountains, and vibrant cobalt blue accents. Finish the day with shopping and browsing at the labyrinthine Old Medina & Souks, where artisans sell traditional leather goods, spices, carpets, and metalwork. **OVERNIGHT MARRAKECH**

## DAY 3 MARRAKECH - RABAT - KENITRA (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel north to Rabat (approx. 3.5 hours), Morocco's political capital with a calm and refined atmosphere. Visit the Royal Palace (Mechouar), the official residence of the King of Morocco, an impressive complex with guards and grand gates. See the Hassan Tower, an unfinished minaret of a mosque from the 12th century, symbolizing Rabat's historical heritage. Nearby is the Mausoleum of Mohammed V, the resting place of the Moroccan king and his sons, featuring intricate zellij tile work and marble. Walk through the Kasbah of the Udayas, a picturesque fortress with narrow streets painted in white and blue, overlooking the Atlantic Ocean and Bouregreg River. Continue to Kenitra (approx. 1 hour), a quieter coastal city ideal for a restful overnight stay. **OVERNIGHT KENITRA**

## DAY 4 KENITRA - CHEFFCHAOUEN - TANGIER (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart early for Chefchaouen (approx. 4 hours), famed for its stunning blue-painted streets set amidst the Rif Mountains. The blue hues are said to symbolize the sky and heaven, creating a peaceful and photogenic atmosphere. Visit the Kasbah Museum with beautiful Andalusian gardens and a small ethnographic museum inside. Wander through the medina, admiring handwoven blankets, pottery, and local crafts. Continue to Tangier (approx. 2 hours), a city that has inspired artists and writers for centuries with its crossroads of African, European, and Arab cultures. Check in and overnight. **OVERNIGHT TANGIER**

## DAY 5 TANGIER - FERRY TO SPAIN - ALGECIRAS - ELVAS (PORTUGAL) (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Tanger Med Port for the ferry crossing (approx. 1.5 hours) to Algeciras, Spain. The Strait of Gibraltar offers spectacular views of Europe and Africa's meeting point. After disembarkation, travel by coach through southern Spain into Portugal (approx. 4.5 hours), reaching Elvas. **OVERNIGHT ELVAS**

## DAY 6 ELVAS - LISBON - ELVAS (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Full-day excursion to Lisbon (approx. 2 hours). Visit the iconic Belem Tower, a defensive fortress and UNESCO World Heritage Site on the Tagus River, showcasing Manueline architectural style. See the Monument to the Discoveries, celebrating Portugal's Age of Exploration with sculptures of famous explorers. Discover the grandeur of Jeronimos Monastery, an exquisite example of late Gothic Manueline style, housing the tomb of Vasco da Gama. Stop at Commerce Square (Praça do Comércio), a grand riverside plaza, and the lively Rossio Square, the heart of Lisbon's downtown. Free time to explore or shop before returning to Elvas. **OVERNIGHT ELVAS**

## DAY 7 ● ELVAS - SEVILLE (SPAIN) (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel to Seville (approx. 3 hours), a city famed for flamenco, Moorish history, and stunning architecture. Visit Plaza de España, built for the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition, decorated with tiled alcoves representing Spain's provinces. See Torre del Oro, a 13th-century watchtower along the Guadalquivir River. Stop at Seville Cathedral, the largest Gothic cathedral in the world, and view the Giralda Tower, originally an Almohad minaret converted into a bell tower. Stroll through Barrio Santa Cruz, the historic Jewish quarter with narrow streets, flower-filled patios, and charming squares. **OVERNIGHT SEVILLE**

## DAY 8 ● SEVILLE - CORDOBA - GRANADA (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Journey to Cordoba (approx. 2 hours), once the capital of Islamic Spain and a center of learning and culture. Visit the breathtaking Mezquita-Cathedral, famous for its forest of columns and red-and-white arches blending Islamic and Christian architecture. Walk across the Roman Bridge, offering views of the Guadalquivir River and city skyline. Continue to Granada (approx. 2 hours), a city with a rich Islamic heritage. **OVERNIGHT GRANADA**

## DAY 9 ● GRANADA - MADRID - LAS VENTAS BULLRING (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning visit to the Alhambra Palace and Generalife Gardens, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring stunning Moorish palaces, intricate tilework, serene patios, and fragrant gardens overlooking the city. Afterward, transfer to Madrid (approx. 4.5 hours). Check in at your hotel and visit Las Ventas Bullring, the largest bullring in Spain, renowned for its neo-Mudéjar architecture. Enjoy photo opportunities and learn about the tradition of bullfighting as part of Spain's culture. **OVERNIGHT MADRID**

## DAY 10 ● MADRID - SANTIAGO BERNABÉU STADIUM - CITY TOUR (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the iconic Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, home of Real Madrid FC, with an optional stadium tour or photo stop. Explore the Islamic Cultural Center of Madrid, Spain's largest mosque and a vibrant hub for Islamic worship and culture, notable for its striking minaret and Andalusian-style architecture. Continue with a city tour visiting Royal Palace (exterior photo stop), Puerta del Sol, the bustling central square, Plaza Mayor, the historic square surrounded by arcades, and Gran Vía, Madrid's main shopping street. Return to hotel for overnight stay. **OVERNIGHT MADRID**

## DAY 11 ● MADRID - LAS ROZAS VILLAGE OUTLET - AIRPORT DEPARTURE (B,MOB)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning shopping spree at Las Rozas Village Outlet, featuring over 100 designer and luxury brands offering discounts year-round. Ideal for picking up souvenirs and last-minute gifts. Transfer to Madrid-Barajas Airport for your flight home, concluding an unforgettable journey across Morocco, Spain, and Portugal.
